


2	Denmark	<p>Badminton Denmark players and coaches are allowed to wear either the flag OR the Badminton Denmark OR the MAAB Probiotics logo throughout a specific tournament.</p> <p>For example, all DEN players and coaches participating in the YONEX Swiss Open 2022 could only wear the flag, or all players and coaches could only wear the Badminton Denmark logo, or all players and coaches could only wear the MAAB Probiotics logo. This cannot change throughout the tournament.</p>

<p><b>5</b></p>	<p><b>New Zealand</b></p>	<p>New Zealand players and coaches are allowed to wear either the flag OR the fern (either color of fern) throughout a specific tournament.</p> <p>For example, all NZL players and coaches participating in the YONEX Swiss Open 2022 could only wear the fern, or all players could only wear the flag.
