Regarding the use of synthetic shuttlecocks in Denmark

Sustainability has become an increasingly important consideration across Danish society. In line with this development, Badminton Denmark has made sustainability a key element of our purpose and long-term vision. We are therefore working actively to help ensure the long-term viability of our sport.

Uncertainty regarding the availability of raw materials for traditional feather shuttlecocks also makes it necessary to explore alternative solutions.

At youth level, events using VICTOR NCS Series have already been conducted in lower-level competitions, and their performance is currently being assessed, but indicates very good potential. The experience indicates that a gradual and well-considered transition to synthetic shuttlecocks may be relevant in the future.

Based on the above, and in order to gain practical experience and collect relevant data, Badminton Denmark has decided to allow the use of VICTOR NCS Series, at this early stage in the development, at relevant Badminton Denmark youth tournaments, and in general the use of synthetic shuttlecocks for club training and lower-level club tournaments during the current season.

Synthetic shuttlecocks are approved for play by Badminton Denmark and may be used; however, each club is responsible for assessing whether their use is appropriate in relation to the level of the tournament or training activity.

By introducing the use of synthetic shuttlecocks in Denmark, we hope to take this step together and gain valuable experience under Danish tournament conditions. This will also allow VICTOR to receive feedback and insights that can contribute to the further development of synthetic shuttlecocks for future generations – potentially even for use at top-level tournaments in the future.
